

The alternative documents are:

- (2) Pass Book of any Nationalized Bank
- (3) Monthly Electricity Bill
- (4) Telephone Bill (Land line) of BSNL,
- (5) Tax Receipt issued by Municipality/ Municipal Corporation
- (6) AADHAR (UID) and
- (7) Employee's Identification Card issued by Central Government/ State Government/ Central Government Undertaking/ State Government Undertaking



No. 2942-WT/3M-17/2012.—22nd August 2012.—In exercise of power conferred under sub-clause (a) and (b) of clause (3) of sub-section (2) of section 3 of West Bengal Motor Vehicles Tax (Amendment) Act, 2012, the Governor is hereby pleased that the value of a new vehicle manufactured in India will be determined by the Taxing Officer from the document (Sale Invoice), containing the information as shown below, by the dealer submitted at the time of registration.

Sale Invoice to be issued by dealer on ex-showroom price in the proforma given at Annexure -I

It shall be issued on the letter-head of the dealer and must contain the TIN No. of the dealer. The details shall include :

- (a) Net base price
(same as declared to Commercial Tax Authority for assessment of VAT)
- (b) VAT (as applicable)
- (c) Entry Tax (if applicable)
- (d) Other taxes / charges, if any
- (e) Total ex-showroom price
[sum of (a) to (d) above]

The following instructions are to be followed for realization of tax of such vehicle :

- (1) Dealer must have VAT registration certificate and TIN No.
- (2) Sale-invoice must be duly signed by the authorized signatory of the dealer.
- (3) Tax of the vehicle is to be paid within 2 (two) days, from the date on which registration is allowed. For any delay in payment of tax penalty will be charged at the rate prescribed under section (11) of the West Bengal Motor Vehicles Act, 1979.
- (4) Sale-invoice submitted by the dealers will be reconciled with the data submitted to the Commercial Tax Authorities.
- (5) For any under invoicing the dealer will be responsible and be liable to pay the difference of tax due along with fine as may be decided by the Transport Department.

- (6) Registering Authority / Taxing Officer shall have the liberty to refuse registration or collection of tax of any vehicle, for which the sale-invoice or data provided is incomplete or false. Penalty on tax payable under section (11) of the West Bengal Motor Vehicles Tax Act, 1979 for any delay in payment of tax caused due to submission of incomplete or false information shall be paid by the dealer.

ORDER

No Objection Certificate (NOC) is issued under Section 48 of the Motor Vehicles Acts, 1988 for the vehicles intended to move outside the jurisdiction of original Registering Authority by way of change of residence or transfer of ownership.

After obtaining NOC, the registered owner shall, within thirty days of the issue of NOC, report to the Registering Authority within whose jurisdiction the vehicle is to be registered as per provisions of Rule 54 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

Now, it is seen that after obtaining NOC, some registered owner failed to report before the Registering Authority to whom the NOC is issued and after passing away a good time sometime they approach the original Registering Authority for cancellation of the same.

Under the MV Act and Rule it is not clearly mentioned that NOC can be cancelled or cannot be cancelled. However no vehicle can remain without Registration for beyond thirty days and as because these vehicles were registered in West Bengal and the registered owners have requested for cancellation of the NOC, the State Government in the Transport Department has decided to regularize such cases under following terms & conditions :

Terms & Conditions

- Declaration in the form of an affidavit may be obtained from the registered owner of the vehicle regarding status, whereabouts of the vehicles during the period between the date on which NOC is issued and the date on which the vehicle owner approaches for cancellation of the NOC, that no case relating to breaking of law has been reported or is pending against the vehicle
- All the Government dues including tax and fines must be cleared.
- The registering Authority shall intimate to the concerned police authority on the cancellation of the NOC of the vehicle and the police authority shall inform if the vehicle in question has committed any crime / offence / illegal activities during the said period to the concerned Registering Authority.
- A fine must be paid in the following manner as mentioned in the Schedule below and permission be issued by the competent Authority as mentioned in the Schedule.



NOTIFICATION

WHEREAS registration of motor vehicles has been a subject dealt with in Chapter-IV of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and in Chapter III of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989;

WHEREAS Rule 126 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 specifically mentions the certifying agencies that grant certificates as to the compliance of provisions of the Act and relevant Rules;

WHEREAS the Government of West Bengal in the Transport Department vide No.2446(26)-WT dated 12.03.1991 requested the Registering Authorities in the State not to register any new model vehicle manufactured by different automobile manufacturers without approval of the Transport Department;

WHEREAS the number of different automobile manufacturers has since been steadily increasing in the country and the number of models/proto types/variants of the different vehicles has also been multiplying over the years;

WHEREAS the manufacturers/ dealers/ purchasers of new vehicles have since been complaining about the delays in registration process, occasionally allegedly leading to flight of registration of vehicles to the neighbouring States (involving loss of revenue for this State);

WHEREAS it has been legally opined that the State Government has no direct role or obligation in the registration process, or in the process of prototype vehicle certification or in granting permission for registering a particular model of a vehicle ;

NOW, THEREFORE, after careful consideration of all the factors involved and in supersession of all earlier orders and practices, the Governor is pleased to decide and direct that the Registering Authorities of this State will henceforth register the vehicles as per laws and rules and on satisfaction of compliance of all the technical points and standards as are enshrined in the laws and the rules and on due checking of all the documents and vehicle testing reports as are involved in such examination.

The Government of West Bengal will henceforth generally refrain from making observations on specific cases of models/ prototypes/ variants but it may, however, from time to time issue directions with regard to particular cases, if necessary and/or with regard to policies for general guidance of the Registering Authorities.

This shall take immediate effect.
